## Leaf Collection



Leaves will be picked up in **bags** only. Do <u>not</u> rake to the curb. Leaves will be picked up from **Until February 28. 2023**.

You must call 609 859-2736 to be placed on a pick up list. No more than 10 bags of leaves will be picked up at a time. If the leaves are in the trash, your trash will NOT be picked up.

Weather permitting, Public Works will be picking up **Holiday Trees** starting January 3, 2023 until January 27, 2023– please call to be put on a list.

Brush pick up will begin in April.

## **Vincentown Historic District**



The **Vincentown Historic District** is a 92-acre historic district roughly bounded by Mill, Church, Pleasant, Main, and Race Streets, and Red Lion Road encompassing the community. It was added to the National Register of Historic Places on September 21, 1988 for its significance in architecture, commerce, industry, religion, and social history. The district includes 160 contributing buildings and 3 contributing sites. The

John Woolston House, a two and one-half story brick house with Federal style, was previously documented by the Historic American Buildings Survey in 1938. The house at 57 Main Street is a three story Italianate style house featuring a cupola with a tree-type finial. It was built c. 1865 and is a key contributing property.


#### Benefits of Yoga...It Just Takes Practice!

- Help people who are overweight or obese lose weight
- Help people with chronic diseases manage their symptoms and improve their quality of life.
