Also we are featuring art classes again at the Old Town Hall (see attached flyers).





If you no longer have the dog, please let us know by calling the Township Office at (609) 859-2736 Opt 5

This information will help to update our records and avoid further notices being sent.

License fees are as follows:

\$9.00 – This fee is for pets that have been spayed or neutered. To qualify, please provide proof of rabies vaccination, and complete the affidavit of spayed or neutering.

\$12.00 – This is for pets that have not been spayed or neutered. To qualify, please provide proof of rabies vaccination.

**Per State regulations

Rabies vaccinations must not expire prior to November 1, 2024 of the year the license is purchased.* Dog licenses <u>are due **yearly starting January 1**</u> and must be renewed prior to March 31 to avoid a late fee.

Licenses obtained after March 31 will be assessed a **\$5.00 late fee.**

Please mail or drop off in "Payment Box" at the township building.




